* Intermezzo winds, brass, and percussion play in BOTH Intermezzo and Wind Ensemble for one tuition fee of \$750. Symphony winds, brass, and percussion play in BOTH Symphony and Wind Ensemble for one tuition fee of \$825 and also includes chamber music at no additional charge. Due to COVID-related restrictions, W/B/P ensembles may change.

** Symphony Strings includes Chamber Music program at no additional charge. This may change for the 20-21 season.

*** Intermezzo string musicians and Wind Ensemble saxophonists who successfully audition for Chamber Music.

****All tuition will be pro-rated should NMYO have to delay or cancel its season due to the pandemic.** Once the in-person season has begun, students who choose to withdraw from the program within the first four weeks of rehearsal will receive a prorated tuition refund. No refunds will be issued after this four-week period. Musicians who choose not to return for the second semester will not receive a refund.

**Musicians receive their music via email after the registration fee is received (or as soon as music is available thereafter).*

***Musicians will not be allowed to participate in NMYO in-person rehearsals until forms are complete and either the remainder of the tuition payment is received or a payment plan is established.*

2020-2021 FEE SCHEDULE, PAYMENT POLICY, & SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Tuition Discounts, Rebates, Financial Aid

Multi-Ensemble Discount – Musicians in both a Sunday and Monday ensemble, such as a Flute Choir and an Orchestra/Wind Ensemble, receive a \$150 discount off the combined tuition. Musicians who play in both Wind Ensemble and Intermezzo Orchestra pay just one fee of \$750. Musicians who play in both Wind Ensemble and Symphony Orchestra pay just one fee of \$825 which also includes chamber music. In 2020-2021, the discount will be pro-rated when we begin in-person rehearsals. Due to pandemic-related restrictions, NMYO's ensemble offerings may be altered to comply with state and federal mandated safety standards.

Family Discount – Families with three or more children in NMYO receive 30% discount off the lowest pro-rated tuition.

New Member Referral Rebate – NMYO families receive a \$25 tuition rebate each time they refer a musician who becomes a NMYO member paying full tuition. The 'New Musician Referral Rebate Form' must be submitted to NMYO prior to the new musician's audition. Obtain this form by contacting the NMYO office.

Program Book Rebate – Families who procure more than \$120 in advertisement revenue will receive a rebate check equal to 25% of the amount exceeding the \$120 requirement. (Rebates do not apply to ad set-up and design fees.)
Note: There will be no Program Book in 2020-2021.

Payment Plans – Pro-rated tuition is due in full in the date when NMYO can resume in-person rehearsals a monthly payment plan is established. Monthly payments plans are automatically withdrawn by NMYO from the family's checking account via ACH debit. Contact the office for a Payment Plan form and submit by the date of the first in-person rehearsal.

Tuition Assistance – Assistance is available for all families with demonstrated need. No musician is rejected for financial reasons. Contact the NMYO office for a financial aid form and submit it with the first two pages of your Form 1040. All financial assistance will be considered on an individual basis and kept confidential.
