Due to pandemic-related restrictions, NMYO's ensemble offerings may be altered to comply with state and federal mandates and guidelines. NMYO reserves the right to cancel an ensemble due to insufficient enrollment. Those affected will be notified and, if paid, the registration fee and tuition will be refunded.

- [^] The higher tuition rates apply to those paying by credit card. The credit card fee is non-refundable.
- [†] Each NMYO family is required to procure a minimum of \$120 in sponsorships. Those who do not wish to procure sponsorships pay the \$120 fee.
- * Intermezzo winds, brass, and percussion play in BOTH Intermezzo and Wind Ensemble for one tuition fee of \$750. Symphony winds, brass, and percussion play in BOTH Symphony and Wind Ensemble for one tuition fee of \$825 which includes chamber music at no additional charge.
- ** Symphony Strings includes Chamber Music program at no additional charge.
- *** Intermezzo string musicians and others who successfully audition for Chamber Music.
- + Audition fee of \$25 applies to musicians new to NMYO. Audition fee of \$15 applies to returning NMYO musicians.

Payment and Other Deadlines

Within the first four weeks of rehearsal, students who withdraw from the program receive a prorated tuition refund. There are no refunds after this four-week period. The registration fee is non-refundable unless a program is canceled due to insufficient enrollment. Musicians who choose not to return for the second semester will not receive a refund.

Payment Plans, Tuition Discounts, Rebates, Financial Aid

Payment Plan – Tuition is due in full on September 12 unless a payment plan is established. Monthly payment plans divide the tuition into 7 months, September through March. Tuition is automatically withdrawn by NMYO from the family's checking account via ACH debit. Contact the office for a Payment Plan form and submit by September 12. There is no additional charge to establish the Payment Plan unless there are insufficient funds in your account when the monthly amount is withdrawn.

Multi-Ensemble Discount – Musicians in both a Sunday and Monday ensemble, such as a Flute Choir and an Orchestra/Wind Ensemble, receive a \$150 discount off the combined tuition. Musicians who play in both Wind Ensemble and Intermezzo Orchestra pay just one fee of \$750. Musicians who play in both Wind Ensemble and Symphony Orchestra pay just one fee of \$825 that also includes chamber music.

Family Discount – Families with three or more children in NMYO receive 30% discount off the lowest tuition.

New Member Referral Rebate – NMYO families receive a \$25 tuition rebate check each time they refer a musician who becomes a NMYO member. Please submit the 'New Musician Referral Rebate Form' to NMYO prior to the new musician's audition. Obtain this form by contacting the NMYO office.

Tuition Assistance – Assistance is available for all families with demonstrated need. No musician is rejected for financial reasons. Contact the NMYO office for a financial aid form and submit it with the applicable pages of your Form 1040 by September 12. All financial assistance will be considered on an individual basis and kept confidential.
